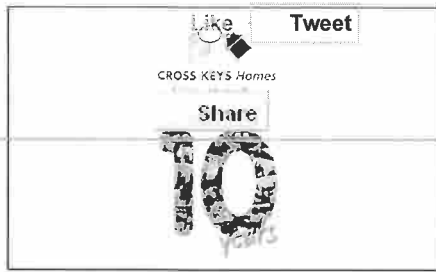

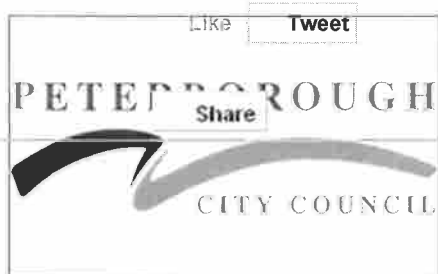
Innovators Challenged to Create the Water Company of the Future

Peterborough City Council has secured £4m of Government 'Green Deal Communities' funding to subsidise energy efficiency home improvements to a large number of homes around the city centre. When combined with funding secured under the Energy Company Obligation and customer Green Deal Plans, the total comes



to more than £13 million. PCC will shortly launch a scheme providing grants for energy efficiency measures such as Solid Wall Insulation, replacement boilers, replacement double glazing, cavity wall insulation and loft insulation.

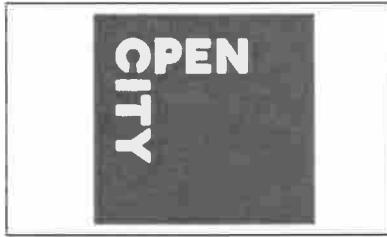
Next Digital Cluster
